

Displaying Phoca Gallery images in articles with help of Phoca Gallery plugin:


- Install [Phoca Gallery component](#)
- Install [Phoca Gallery content plugin](#) and enable it in Plugin manager.

So if you have installed the component and plugin, then simply take the gallery (album) ID and use a simple code to insert it into the article.
